MONTHLY NEWS AND INFORMATION FROM YOUR RETIREMENT BOARD

ANNUAL AUDIT

The Fund's auditors, Legacy Professional, LLP, completed their annual audit of our financial records, and the results were reviewed and accepted at the June 15, 2022, Board meeting – December 31, 2021, Audited Financial Report. A quote from the audit opinion:

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of Firemen's Annuity and Benefit Fund of Chicago (the Plan), a fiduciary fund of the City of Chicago, Illinois, which comprise the combining statements of pension plan fiduciary net position and health insurance supplement plan net position, and the related combining statements of changes in pension plan fiduciary net position and health insurance supplement plan net position as of and for the year ended December 31, 2021, and the related notes to the financial statements.

In our opinion, the financial statements referred to above present fairly, in all material respects, the plan net position of Firemen's Annuity and Benefit Fund of Chicago as of December 31, 2021, and the changes in plan net position for the year then ended, in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America...

Thank you to Comptroller Jackie Vlahos and staff for their diligence and professionalism in assisting in a successful and timely completion of the audit.

ACTUARIAL VALUATION RESULTS

The Fund's actuaries, Segal, completed their Actuarial Valuation Report for 2021 and the results were also reviewed and accepted at the June 15, 2022, Board meeting – <u>December 31, 2021</u>, <u>Actuarial Valuation Report</u>. A few items from the report and summary that warrant mentioning:

- The market value funded ratio improved from 19.9% to 20.9%. This is still critically low, but actuarial funding is beginning to trend the Fund towards the expectation of 90% funding by 2055.
- Employer statutory required contributions booked for 2021 (received in 2022) are expected to be \$367.1M. The number increases to \$398.6 for 2022, and \$427.7 for 2023. These amounts do not include the mandatory Exempt Rank funding of approximately \$1.6M annually.

- Employer contributions are projected by the actuaries to exceed benefit payments, refunds, and expenses through 2026.
- The Fund has 10,154 members: 4,735 active, 154 inactive, and 5,265 retirees and beneficiaries. A slight increase in each category from 2020.
- Noted in the Fund Summary for 2021, there were 190 service retirements, 4 ordinary disabilities, 3 occupational disabilities, 25 duty disabilities, and 74 beneficiary annuities granted.

It is important as participants of the Fund to familiarize yourself with both the Audited Financial Statements and the Actuarial Reports which are linked to this newsletter or available at FABF.Org. As your Board Secretary, I and Fund staff are available to address questions or concerns you may have on either report.
