UPDATE ON ACTIVE FIREFIGHTER TRUSTEE ELECTION

Under provisions of the Illinois Pension Code, an election is being held to fill the office of **Active Firefighter Member Trustee** of The Retirement Board. The position will become vacant **on December 1, 2023**, because of the expiration of the term of an incumbent. Ballots <u>have been</u> mailed to all active members eligible to vote. If you do not receive a ballot by October 17th or your ballot has been spoiled, you may complete an affidavit for a replacement ballot at the following link Request for Ballot Affidavit. All members are encouraged to exercise their right to vote.

FALL PRE-RETIREMENT SEMINAR

ANNUITANT - CONTACT INFORMATION VERFICATION UPDATE

The Fund distributed address and phone number verification form letters (Jurat) to all current annuitants in August. The letter required the annuitant to verify address and phone number detail by executing the form with a public Notary. Active employees of the Chicago Fire Department are not required to verify their address with the Fund until they begin to receive an annuity.

As of this letter, over 80% of the required verification forms have been returned to the Fund. Dedicated staff are working to process these forms and to timely update member records. For annuitants that did not return the verification form, a second letter will be sent at the end of October. The Board understands there are circumstances that may have prevented a timely return

of the first letter, however, a continued failure to respond to this legal requirement may result in a suspension of benefits.

The Union and Fund Offices are available to notarize these forms; all authorized notaries are approved by the Fund for the certification of this Form. The executed form letter - unique to each annuitant - needs to be physically returned to the Fund Office at 20 S. Clark, <u>Suite 300</u>; faxed or emailed forms will not be accepted.

HELPS UPDATE

The Healthcare Enhancement for Local Public Safety Act (HELPS) is part of the existing federal tax law. HELPS allows eligible retired public safety officers to exclude gross income up to \$3,000 in annual distributions from a governmental retirement plan to pay qualified health care insurance or long-term care insurance premiums. Members who have separated from service and have attained normal retirement age or who are separated due to a disability are eligible for HELPS. To take advantage of the tax exclusion, a retiree must be receiving a pension distribution.

Changes implemented upon the passage of SECURE Act 2.0 modify existing HELPS rules and became effective for distributions made after December 29, 2022. **NEW** - The direct payment requirement under HELPS is now optional, namely the Fund does not have to make the premium payment to the healthcare insurer. The retiree can now directly make the premium payment and remain eligible for the tax exclusion.
