Should you resign 8 a.m. 11/02/2025 your annuity would amount to \$10,049.00 (75%) a month. You would be entitled to receive 3% of your monthly base annuity payment added to your annuity beginning 12/01/2026 and the same added January 1st of each year thereafter, continuing for your lifetime.
