The Real Cost: 10-Year Projection

Scenario: Retiree at age 55 with spouse — no contractual coverage

Monthly BCBS PPO
(EE + Spouse)

\$1,874

/month

Annual Premium
Cost

\$22,488

/year

10-Year Total
Out-of-Pocket

\$224,880

over 10 years

$$\$1,874.48 \times 12 \text{ months} = \$22,488 / \text{yr} \rightarrow \$22,488 \times 10 \text{ years} = \$224,880$$

Medicare: Key Questions & Milestones

Answer these questions well before you turn 65:

1 Do I have the required SS/Medicare credits?

Confirm eligibility with Medicare — spousal credits also count from marriage dates. Receive written confirmation.

2 When should I contact Medicare?

Contact Medicare 3 months prior to your 65th birthday. Do not wait until the last minute.

3 Who still needs non-Medicare coverage?

Any spouse or dependents not yet eligible must obtain coverage: pay City's full premium or shop the individual market.

4 What Medicare Supplement & Rx options do I have?

(1) Local 2 Group Sponsored Voluntary Plan (2) Individual market plans (3) Voluntary plans through City of Chicago.

Common Healthcare Questions

ACTION REQUIRED Subrogation Letters – Coghlan Law Firm

If you receive a letter from Coghlan Law Firm (312-357-9200), fill out the form and return it immediately. This firm is hired by the City of Chicago – ignoring it will delay your healthcare claims.

When a Member Passes Away

Active members: beneficiary receives City-issued MetLife group insurance of \$75,000. Upon retirement, this benefit ends. Health insurance continues for retired members until Medicare eligibility. Upon a retiree's death, spouse/dependent coverage ends immediately.

KNOW THIS Medicare Effective Date – Birthday Rule

Medicare begins the 1st of the month preceding your 65th birthday. Example: Birthday March 29 → Medicare starts March 1. Exception: If born on the 1st, Medicare begins the prior month.

Active-to-Retired Transition Gap

Expect a 4-6 week gap where you are not yet in the system. Coverage is retroactive to your retirement date. Ensure you have adequate medications before your last day. Contact Bill Oswald at Local 2 for emergency overrides.

PRE-AUTH REQUIRED CT, PET Scan, or MRI

Call Telligen at 800-373-3727 to pre-certify before any CT, PET Scan, or MRI. When pre-certified, the cost is fully covered. Skipping this step may result in out-of-pocket costs.

TIP Routine Labs – Use Free-Standing Labs

Avoid hospital-affiliated labs – they carry additional charges. Use free-standing labs for routine bloodwork. Even if your doctor sends an order in a hospital setting, request an outside facility.

Ambulance Transport Billing

Ambulance transport is a covered benefit for member and spouse. The City's outsourced vendor is unfamiliar with your CBA – you will receive a bill. Follow the General Order for Ambulance Transport Billing.
